Vocal Coach & Singing Teacher

Since 1993, Loic has been teaching singing in both France and Australia. Several of his protégés have become professional singers and song writers and got their album produced. Some others got parts in musicals and opera rocks. As a vocal coach, Loic's approach is a mix of the classical techniques from Opera (i.e.: Abdominal breathing, Vocal Placement and Scales), the remarkable and highly efficient techniques from the Actors Studios (L.A.) and some very ancient techniques that Loic learned from Japan and India.

Loic brings with him nearly 35 years of singing experience and more than 20 years as an artistic director.

"I treat and coach everyone who comes to me to learn singing like a professional. To me, there is no compromise with singing or music. We don't negotiate with music. If you want to sing, do it perfectly or don't do it at all. Anywhere in between is a disaster. Singing (and playing music) requires commitment, strength and courage. THAT is what I teach, the techniques are just a pretext."
